

**BIG LAKE CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**

APRIL 16, 2021

1. CALL TO ORDER

Acting Mayor Halverson called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL

Council Members present: Acting Mayor Ken Halverson, Sam Hanson and Paul Seefeld. Council Member absent: Mayor Paul Knier. Also present: Council Member Elect Kim Noding, City Administrator Clay Wilfahrt, Finance Director Deb Wegeleben, and City Clerk Gina Wolbeck.

3. PROPOSED AGENDA

Council Member Hanson motioned to adopt the proposed Agenda as presented. Seconded by Council Member Seefeld, unanimous ayes, Agenda adopted.

4. BUSINESS – Canvass Results of the April 13, 2021 Special City Election

Gina Wolbeck presented an Abstract of Votes Cast at the April 13, 2021 Special City Election. Wolbeck reviewed that 516 voters out of 6,841 registered voters cast a ballot at the Special Election which equates to a 7.5% voter turnout. Kim Noding received the highest vote count and Ketti Green has 7 days to file a request for a Discretionary Recount which would be funded by the requesting candidate. Pending no recount is requested and all financial reporting requirements have been met, Council Member Elect Noding will receive her Certificate of Election on April 23, 2021, and will take the Oath of Office prior to the April 28, 2021 City Council Workshop.

Motion by Council Member Seefeld to approve Resolution No. 2021-27 canvassing the results of the April 13, 2021 Special City Election. Seconded by Council Member Hanson, unanimous ayes, motion carried.
