### **Suspect Arrested Possessing Heroin**

On May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 1:15 a.m. Officer Nic Prigge observed a suspicious vehicle in Lakeside Park after the 10:00 p.m. closing time. Officer Prigge contacted the driver to inquire about why he and his passenger were in the park after hours. During this conversation, it was discovered the driver had a revoked drivers license, and outstanding arrest warrants. The driver was placed under arrest.

As Officer Prigge was taking the driver into custody, he observed a scale in the vehicle consistent with the type used to weigh narcotics. Officer Prigge, undertook a search of the vehicle, during which time he located a plastic baggie on the floor, residue in it field tested positive for heroin. Officer Prigge searched a purse belonging to the passenger, Abigail Snow (Age 23 – Little Falls). In the purse, two pipes were located, consistent with those used to smoke narcotics. During a search of Snow, a plastic baggie containing a powdery substance was located, this substance field tested positive for heroin.

Snow was arrested and booked into the Sherburne County Jail. During a second search while being booked in, Correctional Officers found another baggie of white substance which tested positive for heroin.

Snow was charged by criminal complaint with; Felony 5<sup>th</sup> Degree Controlled Substance Crime (Heroin).
