Suspect Arrested for Methamphetamine Possession

On April 4, 2019 at approximately 10:10pm Officer Silas Reek observed a vehicle with an equipment violation and learned the registered owner had an expired driver's license. The vehicle stopped in a parking lot and Officer Reek made contact with the driver, Grant K. Burnison (Age 33 – Hutchinson, MN).

As Officer Reek was speaking to Burnison, he observed the tip of an e-cig in the center console that was consistent with tips used to smoke THC. Officer Reek asked Burnison about the e-cig and Brunison handed it to him. Officer Reek detected the odor of marijuana coming from the e-cig. The liquid contents inside the e-cig field tested positive for tetrahydrocannabinol (THC).

Officer Reek searched the vehicle and located a folded piece of paper with a crystal-like substance inside. The crystal-like substance field tested positive for methamphetamine and weighed 2.2 grams.

Burnison was arrested and booked into the Sherburne County Jail. Burnison was charged by criminal complaint with; Felony 5th Degree Controlled Substance Crime (methamphetamine – Schedule II controlled substance), Felony 5th Degree Controlled Substance Crime (THC – Schedule I controlled substance).
