Suspect Arrested for Narcotic Possession

On September 1, 2019 at approximately 11:08pm Sergeant Joe Kalla stopped a vehicle for speeding. While speaking to the driver, Heather Rogers (Age 27 – Princeton, MN), Sergeant Kalla observed a green leafy substance that was consistent with marijuana near the driver's door handle area.

Officer Guy Chaffee and his partner, Bruno, were requested to assist with the traffic stop. A canine sniff was completed, and Bruno indicated to the presence of narcotics inside the vehicle. The vehicle was searched and a small plastic baggie containing a crystal-like substance was found under the front passenger seat area. The crystal-like substance field tested positive for methamphetamine and later weighed 1.3 grams.

A glass pipe that smelled of burnt marijuana was found in the driver's door map pocket area, and a glass bulb-stemmed pipe with white residue, consistent with methamphetamine use, was located in a case within a Victoria's Secret bag in the backseat area.

Rogers was arrested and booked into the Sherburne County jail. Rogers was charged by criminal complaint with; Felony 5th Degree Controlled Substance (Schedule II controlled substance).
