Information requested that is defined by state statute as public may be released on request. Private data containing your permanent address/home telephone number will be used to contact you. If you become employed with the city, your social security number will be released to the Social Security Administration and Internal Revenue Service for payroll and tax purposes. You are not legally required to provide the information. Failure to provide may result in a delay in notifying you. This information is available only to the person the information is about, and anyone authorized by you or law to see it. I authorize that my address and telephone number can be given to another election judge to Sherburne County election personnel, or Big Lake School District election personnel for the sole purpose of contacting me regarding election work. I waive my right to claim and hereby agree to hold harmless the City of Big Lake and any of its agents or employees for any injury or damage which I may experience as a direct or indirect result of the intended use of this information.

2020 Election Judge Training Options

Regular Election Judges are required to complete a two-hour training session. Only judges who will be serving as a Head Judge need to complete an additional hour of training. All training is coordinated through the Sherburne County Auditor/Treasurer's Office. In past years, Election Judges that served were required to attend training in-person at the Sherburne County Government Center in Elk River. In 2016, the County started offering on-line training.

THIS YEAR – the mandatory training will again be offered as an ON-LINE training that you will be able to complete at any location you choose (your home, tablet, City Hall, etc.). At this point, Sherburne County hasn't provided the website link for the training. This information will be sent out to Election Judges when it becomes available. For any judges that do not have access to a computer or tablet, an in-person training session will be offered at a later date. You must contact the City Clerk's Office to sign up for this class.
