Suspect Arrested After Firearm Incident

On July 27th at about 1:30 a.m. Big Lake Police responded to Lillie's Bar and Grill in regards to a female in the establishment brandishing a handgun. On the Officer's arrival, the suspect had fled the scene. Through their investigation Officers determined that Deanna Dols (Age 39 – Big Lake) had been involved in an altercation with another patron in the establishment with whom a domestic relationship existed. Dols left, then returned a short time later with what was described by witnesses as a large frame handgun. Dols waived the handgun and pointed it at the other patron while yelling; "you want to mess with me now?" Dols then left the establishment. Dols was taken into custody a short time later during a traffic stop and transported to the Sherburne County Jail. A .357 magnum revolver was recovered at her residence.

On July 28th an Investigator from the Big Lake Police Department executed a search warrant at Lillie's Bar and Grill to retrieve footage from a video recorder on site. That footage confirmed witness accounts of what took place. Dols was charged by criminal complaint with; Felony Terroristic Threats, Gross Misdemeanor Possessing a Pistol Without a Permit, and Intentionally Pointing of a Gun.

Deputies from the Sherburne County Sheriff's Office, as well as an Officer from the Becker Police Department assisted throughout this incident.
