### **Suspects Charged with Burglary to Liberty Elementary School**

On July 23 at 9:50 a.m. Big Lake Police Officers were dispatched to Liberty Elementary School in Big Lake regarding a Burglary Complaint. In taking their initial report, Officers were provided information that the security system had captured video of individuals in the school during late hours, skateboarding in the hallways. All three individuals were identified by the video, and subsequently interviewed by a Big Lake Police Investigator.

Upon completion of the investigation, it was determined that the three juveniles had been in Liberty Elementary School a total of 6 times between June 8<sup>th</sup> and July 23<sup>rd</sup>. Entry to the building was gained by means other than forced entry. During these 6 entries into the school the following items were taken; 1 pad, portable radios, and office supplies.

All three juveniles were charged by criminal complaint this week with; 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Burglary (Felony), Theft of Property (Felony), and Trespassing (Misdemeanor). Names of the three charged cannot be released due to their age, and Minnesota Data Practices Regulations.
