Suspect Arrested For Methamphetamine Possession

On July 28, 2015 at 1:30 a.m. Officer Sam Norlin was on routine patrol near Tarry Town Road and Katrina Lane, when he observed a male walking with a backpack. Officer Norlin stopped to talk to the individual, who stated he was on the way to a residence on Katrina Lane. Officer Norlin recognized the address as one in which a no trespassing order was in place from its owners, the male was instructed not to go to the residence. A short time later Officer Norlin observed the same male, identified as Kendall Porter (Age 23 – No Permanent Address), go to the residence he was instructed to stay away from. Officer Norlin approached Porter, and asked for his name and date of birth. Porter gave a false name and date of birth to Officer Norlin. When Porter's real identity was determined, he was found to have outstanding felony arrest warrants in Wright County. Porter was placed under arrest for the arrest warrants. In searching Porter after arrest, and napkin was found with a crystal substance which field tested positive for methamphetamine. Porter was transported to the Sherburne County Jail.

Porter was charged by criminal complaint with; Possessing a Scheduled Substance (Felony).
