Suspect Arrested for Possession of Ecstasy

On January 14 at 11:30 p.m. Officer Guy Chaffee was on routine patrol in the area of Polk Street when he observed footprints in the fresh snow going from car to car. Officer Chaffee exited his patrol car and began to follow the footprints, suspecting someone was either looking for a vehicle to steal or committing thefts from vehicles. The footprints continued through several backyards and around residences. The footprints ended at a residence on Lee Street. After going to the door of the residence, an occupant relayed that a person identified as Shawn Glover (Age 28 – Rockford MN) just arrived and was changing out of wet clothing. Officer Chaffee observed shoes that matched the footprints in the snow he had been following, they belonged to Glover. Glover was placed under arrest for the vehicle tampering that had been observed. During an inventory of Glover's property, pills were located that field tested positive for being MDMA (Ecstasy), a Schedule I controlled substance. During a mirandized statement, Glover admitted the pills were his.

Glover was charged by criminal complaint with; 1 Count of 5th Degree Controlled Substance Possession (Felony).
