**Suspect Arrested for Auto Theft and Possession of
Methamphetamine**

On June 11, 2015 at 1:30 p.m. Investigator Rich Berg and Chief Joel Scharf were dispatched to Taft Street in the City of Big Lake on the following complaint. Information was provided that a stolen auto from Wright County was observed being operated in this area, a witness remained on the phone with dispatch providing up to date information on the vehicle and suspect's location.

As Investigator Berg and Chief Scharf arrived in the area, they located a suspect identified as Tylor Derrick Daugherty (Age 23 – Princeton) removing items from the vehicle, which was now parked. Daugherty matched the description provided by the witness as having operated the stolen Ford Escort. After confirming the vehicle was in fact stolen from Wright County, Daugherty was placed under arrest for auto theft.

During the course of the arrest, a glass pipe containing a substance which field tested positive for methamphetamine was located in Daugherty's pants pocket. Tylor Daugherty was transported to the Sherburne County Jail where he is currently in custody.

Charges for this incident will include; Felony Theft/Possessing a Stolen Vehicle, Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance (methamphetamine), Driving After Revocation, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.
