Suspect Arrested for Break-In at Sand Prairie Dental

On March 1 at 2:25 a.m. Big Lake Police were dispatched to a security alarm at Sand Prairie Dental, located in the Marketplace Development. When the security alarm company placed a phone call into Sand Prairie Dental, a male suspect answered the phone. This suspect was identified as Isaiah Washburn (Age 36 – Big Lake). On their arrival, Officers found the front window to the building to have been broken out.

Responding Officers observed Washburn look out of a room, and subsequently exit the building towards them. Washburn was taken into custody at this point without incident. In a recorded interview Washburn admitted that he threw a birdbath through the front window, then entered the building for safety as someone was after him. Washburn exhibited characteristics of being under the influence of a substance, he admitted to having taken narcotics. Washburn was placed under arrest and transported to the Sherburne County Jail.

Washburn was charged by criminal complaint with; 1) Count of 1st Degree Felony Property Damage.

Officers from Sherburne and Wright County Sheriff's Departments, Elk River and Becker Police Departments assisted with this incident.
