Stolen Harley Davidson Recovered in Big Lake

On 10-15-2014 at 9:00 p.m. Big Lake Police Officers were at 750 Minnesota Avenue on a call for service related to a felony warrant arrest. Officers observed a 2004 Harley Davidson Motorcycle in the parking lot, which appeared to have been repainted. In looking more closely, Officers could see where a grinder had been used to remove the original paint, and it had since been repainted with what appeared to be white spray paint. In checking the registration, the motorcycle was reported stolen in Minneapolis about 1 month prior. The motorcycle was taken into custody at this time. Further investigation showed video surveillance of the suspect driving the motorcycle into the complex. The clothing the suspect was wearing has been recovered, and the driver positively identified as the same individual arrested on the felony arrest warrant.

This case file has been forwarded to the Sherburne County Attorney's Office for long form charges of Possession of a Stolen Motor Vehicle. The suspect is currently in custody on charges from an unrelated matter, his name is being withheld pending formal charging in this matter.
