Suspect Arrested for Child Maltreatment

On November 18, 2014 a Big Lake Police Investigator undertook an interview with a suspect as a result of a child maltreatment report made to the Big Lake Police Department. The initial information provided to the Investigator indicated that a child under the age of 4 had sustained injuries while in the care and custody of an individual identified as; Akinmusayo Akinde (Age 25- Big Lake). The child had multiple injuries which were discovered during the initial report. During the interview with Adkinde, he admitted to having utilized a belt to discipline the child, striking the child multiple times.

Following the interview, Akinde was placed under arrest by Investigator Terry Nordquist and transported to the Sherburne County Jail. Akinde was charged by criminal complaint with; Malicious Punishment of a Child (Felony), and 3rd Degree Assault-Victim under Four (Felony).
