## **Suspect Arrested for Stolen Church Property**

On October 15 at 12:00 am, Officer Nic Prigge was on routine patrol when he observed a vehicle with a malfunctioning taillight. Officer Prigge initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle, driven by David Singer (Age 19 – Andover). While speaking to Singer, Officer Prigge could detect an odor of burned marijuana. A passenger later admitted to having a smoking device which smelled of burned marijuana.

During the course of the stop, Officer Sam Norlin arrived to assist with a search of the vehicle. As a result of the search for narcotics, the following items were located; 2 laptop computers, mini-Mac, and a Glock Handgun. The Glock handgun was in a compartment on the driver's door. It was determined through interviews that the electronic items had been taken during a burglary of Horizon Church in the Andover area. The handgun had been taken from a lock box without permission from another individual the same day. Singer was placed under arrested and transported to the Sherburne County Jail.

Singer was charged by criminal complaint with; 1 Count of Receiving Stolen Property. An investigation is ongoing in Anoka County related to the burglary of the church.
