Suspect Charged with Terroristic Threats

On May 25th at 5:42 pm Big Lake Police Officers Todd Siebert and Sam Norlin were dispatched to the area of Phyllis St. and Rose Dr. regarding a threats complaint. On their arrival, Officers Siebert and Norlin interviewed three juveniles who indicated that a suspect identified as Caleb Schrieber (Elk River) had driven up onto the curb at them. A verbal altercation took place, and Schrieber left going to Lake Liquors. The juveniles went to Lake Liquors to confront Schrieber about the driving conduct. During the course of the altercation, Schrieber removed his shirt, retrieved a screwdriver from his car, and threatened to stab the juveniles "to death" if they did not leave. In Schrieber's statement, he indicated that he had removed his shirt anticipating a fight and that one of the juveniles kicked his car. Also in his interview, Schrieber stated that he had the right to defend himself, and if that meant killing others, that's what he would have to do.

Schrieber was also determined to have consumed alcohol, based on field sobriety testing he was arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol. Schrieber was charged by criminal complaint with; Terroristic Threats (Felony), and Driving under the Influence of Alcohol (Gross Misdemeanor).
