## **Suspect Arrested on Felony Warrant After Foot Pursuit**

On May 21st, Big Lake Police Officers were dispatched the scene of a reported domestic assault. Officers determined that Robert Allen Haberman (Age 39 – Big Lake) was the suspect in the incident and had left the scene prior to Officers arrival. Through their investigation, Officer's determined that Haberman had physically assaulted a victim at the residence involved. During the assault, Haberman placed his hands around the victim's throat told her that today was her last day and that he was going to kill her. The victim broke free and fled to another room in the house, locking the door. Haberman kicked in the door as the victim fled from the house and called 911. Haberman fled the scene at this point, Officers were unable to locate him.

On June 23rd, Big Lake Police Office Guy Chaffee observed Haberman on a motorcycle in the 100 block of Sherburne Ave. When Officer Chaffee attempted to contact Haberman, he jumped off the motorcycle and fled on foot through adjacent yards. Officer Chaffee apprehended Haberman a short time later, Haberman is currently in custody in the Sherburne County Jail on the below listed charges.

Haberman was charged by criminal complaint with; Terroristic Threats (Felony) and Domestic Assault-2nd Offence (Gross Misdemeanor).
