### **Suspect Arrested 4 Times in 5 Days**

Ryder Toth (Age 18 – Big Lake) has been charged with 7 separate criminal offenses over the past 5 days in the City of Big Lake. Big Lake Police Officers have been dispatched to 4 separate incidents involving Toth, resulting in the charges. Incidents with Toth include:

08/19: Shoplifting – Coborn’s - Charged with Theft of Property.

08/20: Shoplifting (1) - Super America – Charged with Theft of Property.

08-20: Suspicious Activity – Lakeside Park – Charged with Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

08-20: Shoplifting (2) – Super America – Charged with Theft of Property.

08-24: Theft from a Vehicle – Lake Street North – Charged with Theft from a Vehicle, Fleeing a Police Officer, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

On the 08/24 incident Big Lake Police were dispatched to the 300 block of Lake Street North at 4:00 am after a citizen reported a male on a bicycle had just entered their vehicle. Officer Jesse Gilbertson located Toth, who fled from the scene on bike. With the assistance of Officer Guy Chaffe, Toth was located and taken into custody. Items taken from the vehicle were recovered in his possession, in addition to drug paraphernalia. Toth is currently in custody at the Sherburne County Jail.
