SUSPECT CHARGED WITH THREATS OF VIOLENCE TO BIG LAKE POLICE OFFICER

On November 12th at 8:45 am, Officer Sam Norlin and Officer Chris Hoard were dispatched to a domestic related threats complaint. During the course of his investigation, Officer Norlin determined that Daniel J. Dwyer (Age 24 – Big Lake, MN) would be arrested for Domestic Assault, and Threats of Violence – Reckless Disregard towards the victim.

Officer Norlin and Officer Hoard located Dwyer and placed him under arrest. While being escorted to the patrol car, Dwyer attempted to pull away from, and resist the Officers. While Officer Norlin was transporting Dwyer to the Sherburne County Jail, Dwyer stated that Officer Norlin should be “assaulted,” and the he would “take out a cop” when he is released. Dwyer continued stating that Officer Norlin harassing him meant “dying,” and that he better “watch his back.”

Dwyer was charged by criminal complaint with; Threats of Violence (felony-Victim 1), Threats of Violence (felony – Officer Norlin), and Domestic Assault (2nd Offense)
