Suspect Arrested with Methamphetamine

On November 7, 2017 at 1:40 am, Sergeant Guy Chaffee was called to the 100 block of Jefferson Boulevard to assist another officer with a suspicious vehicle. Sergeant Chaffee approached the vehicle and observed a female later identified as Ashley Reece (Age 29 – Bird Island). Reece had been seated in the front passenger seat, where Sergeant Chaffee located a purse containing a spoon with white residue on it. Also located in this area, was a pouch containing assorted drug paraphernalia, and a plastic baggie with white powdery substance in it. This substance field tested positive for methamphetamine. During a further search of the vehicle, another bag with white powdery substance was located in the center console, it also field tested positive for methamphetamine. Finally, hypodermic needles and marijuana were also found near the front passenger seat.

Reece was arrested and transported to the Sherburne County Jail. During a follow up interview, Reece admitted the methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia belonged to her. Reece was charged by Criminal Complaint with; 5th Degree Controlled Substance Possession (felony).
