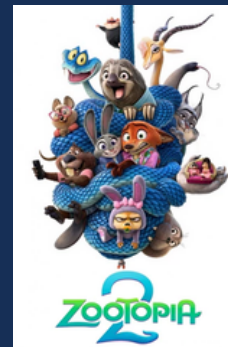

NO SOLICITING

No Soliciting Stickers

Door-to-door sales in the City of Big Lake require a permit from City Hall. If you are visited by a door-to-door salesperson, ask to see their City of Big Lake issued permit. If they do not have the required permit, call the Big Lake Police Department at 763-251-2996 or 911 to report the incident. Residents can purchase a "No Soliciting" window sticker from City Hall. It is illegal for a salesperson to solicit or peddle at a premise where this sign is posted.

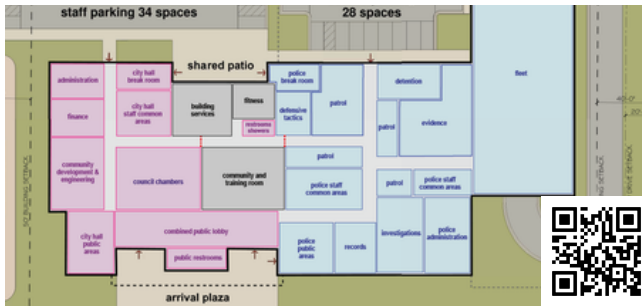

Pedestrian Safety Reminder

With warmer weather coming, be sure to watch for pedestrians. Big Lake has miles of trails and sidewalks to enjoy, and what some don't realize is that pedestrians have the right of way while in a crosswalk. Please be vigilant, especially if you know a crosswalk is coming up.

Yard Waste Facility Updates

There has been a hard reset on all yard waste facility key-cards. Residents of Becker, Big Lake, and Zimmerman can obtain a key-card to access any of the three yard waste facilities. If you already have a key-card, bring it to City Hall to be reset. Your first key-card is free and you can replace the key-card or purchase a second one for \$10.

Note that Elk River's yard waste site will only be open to City of Elk River residents. The City of Big Lake's Yard Waste Facility is located at Big Lake Public Works (18041 198th Avenue) and is open 24/7. Bring a photo ID or utility bill with proof of residency to City Hall (160 Lake St N) during regular office hours to reset or obtain a new key-card during regular office hours (Monday - Thursday: 7:30 a.m. - 5 p.m. and Fridays: 7:30 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.)
